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


Installation & Setup


The Installment Payment Terms app is licensed through Microsoft, follow these instructions to license and initialize the app.

Creating the Subscription

1) Go to the Extension Marketplace and click on the app you want to subscribe to.



2) Search "Installment Payment Terms" in the AppSource to find the Installment Payment Terms offering and open the information page.





3) On the **Drop Down** next to **Buy Now**.




- 7) Go through the Billing information pages.


Now, assign the licenses you purchased to users in your tenant via Admin center. From there you can proceed to install this app.




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11) Click on the app that is just purchased.






12) Click on **Assign Licenses** to assign the licenses to the users that will be using the app.






13) Click on **Install this Product** to install the app in your tenant.




14) Select an environment and click on Install.

Cancelling the Subscription

- 1) To Cancel Subscription, open the **Microsoft 365 admin center** and go to **Billing>>Your Products**.
- 2) Click on the app you want to cancel the subscription for and click on **Cancel Subscription**.



Setup the Installment Payment Terms App

Assign User Permission Set

- 1) Choose the Dicon to enter "User" and click on the related link to open the Users list.
- 2) On the Users list, select users that will require permissions to the Installment Payment Terms app.
- 3) On each of the selected **User Cards**, go to the **User Permission Sets** tab, add the necessary permission sets based on the role of the user:

a) APEINSTALLPMTADMINE

- i) Assign this to the users that are considered administrators of the app and responsible for setting up and maintaining Additional Payment Terms.
- ii) These users must be licensed through the Microsoft 365 admin center.

b) APEINSTALLPMTE

- i) Assign this to the users that are considered users of the app, these users should be any user that can invoice Sales or Purchase documents.
- ii) These users must be licensed through the Microsoft 365 admin center.

c) APEINSTALLPMTREADE

- i) This should be assigned to any users that do not have the ability to invoice sales documents.
- ii) These users **do not need to be licensed**, but this permission set must be assigned to prevent any licensing errors while using areas touched by the app. (ex.: the flowfield on the Payment Terms page.)

d) APEINSTALLPMTDEMO

- i) A special, unlicensed Permission Set available to allow testing this app in a Sandbox
- ii) This permission set is only for use in a Sandbox environment and not licensed for use in a Production environment.


User Guide

Companies need to create installment payments for customers and vendors. Users may run into challenges creating installments using out-of-the-box Business Central Payment Terms. The installments need to be added manually to Purchase and Sales Orders. The Installment Payment Terms app will help you easily split payments into installments. Use the payment term codes with additional installment payment terms on Purchase and Sales Orders/Invoices. After posting a purchase or sales invoice, the system will automatically split the payment according to the installment payment setup.

Creating the Payment Terms

Create Installment Payment Terms

- 1) Open the payment terms page and enter a new Payment Term.
 - There are two columns added to the Payment Terms table to manage Installment
 Payments.
 - Installment Payment Amount Percentage: Enter the percentage of the order total for this part of the payment term split.
 - No. of installment payments: This is a flowfield that shows the number of Installment Payment splits that have been associated to this Payment Term.




Add Additional Payments Terms

- 1) Click on the number in the **No. of Installment Payments** field to drill into and open the **Additional Installment Payment Terms** page.
- 2) Setup any additional Payment Terms



- Due Date Calculation: Date formula to calculate the additional payments.
- o **Discount Date Calculation:** Date formula to calculate payment discounts.
- o **Discount %:** Discount percentage to use if paid within the discount period.
- Installment Payment Amount Percentage:



NOTE: If there are rounding issue, the system will add the difference the last payment entry.



Add Installment Payment Amount Percentage

You can also enter different percentage per payment installment.

1) Setup the payment percentage on the **Payment Terms** page for the first installment.



2) Setup additional payment percentages on the Additional Installment Payment Terms page.



- 3) Add the new **Installment Payment Terms** to the Customer or Vendor Card in the **Payment Terms** field to default on documents.
- 4) Create a new Sales Order with the new Installment Payment Terms.
- 5) Post the Sales Invoice
- 6) Go to the **Customer Ledger Entries** page to view the entries created from the new **Installment Payment Terms**.






Once setup, the system will automatically split the payments, according to the records in the additional installment payment terms page.




Limitations


1) Installment Payment Terms need to sum up to 100 percent. If they do not, the system will display this error on Post Invoice.



2) Installment Payment Terms cannot be used on Credit Memos.



- To correct, Remove Installment Payment terms from the Credit Memo and Post the document.
 - Go to the Customer/Vendor Ledger Entries page. Select the Posted Credit Memo. Select Process Apply Entries and apply the entries manually.



3) Due to localization limitations, US users will need to manually enter the IRS 1099 Amounts on purchase documents or create an extension to populate the 1099 fields after posting installment payment invoices.
